What you need to provide

- Empty room at least 25sqm; with minimal or blacked-out windows
- 3-pin power sockets at floor level and extension cords
- Loose parts and consumables to support your children's investigations
- Basic sound system preferable but not compulsory
- Daily start-up and shut-down of the installation – training will be provided. This involves turning on the power, setting the colours of the lights and light cleaning
